

**Class 1 Facilities: No smoking (Appendix 1 of the Ordinance)**

(1)	Kindergarten, elementary school, junior high school, compulsory education school, senior high school, secondary education school, school for special needs education, university, specialized vocational high school/college, and other similar facilities
(2)	a) Hospital, clinic or midwifery home b) Pharmacy c) Facility where practitioners of massage and finger pressure, acupuncture, moxibustion or judo osteopathy provide treatment
(3)	Theater, movie theater or entertainment hall
(4)	Observation gallery
(5)	a) Meeting hall or public hall b) Crematorium or ossuary c) Shrine, temple, church, and other similar facilities
(6)	Exhibition hall
(7)	Gymnasium, swimming pool, bowling alley, and other sports facilities
(8)	Public bathhouse
(9)	Department store, market, and other retail shops
(10)	Bank and other financial institutions
(11)	Office of postal, telecommunications, waterworks, electric power, gas or heat supply service business
(12)	(a) Facilities used for boarding, waiting, etc. of passengers who use public transportation (b) Train, car and other vehicles or ship which are used for transportation of passengers (of which routes start and end within the prefecture)
(13)	Library, museum, art gallery, and other similar facilities
(14)	Zoo, botanical garden, amusement park, and other similar facilities
(15)	Nursing home for the elderly, nursery, welfare home, welfare center for the elderly, recreational facility for children, welfare center for persons with physical disabilities, and other similar facilities
(16)	Government office/facility
(17)	Building or structure where public facilities listed in the preceding items or Appendix 2 are located (limited to areas for public purposes, such as entrance, hallway, stairs, elevator and restroom)

**Class 2 Facilities: No smoking or partial restriction of smoking (Appendix 2 of the Ordinance)**

(1)	a) Eating and drinking establishment b) Cabaret, café, nightclub, rental room and restaurant, and other similar facilities
(2)	Hotel, inn, and other similar facilities
(3)	a) Game arcade, karaoke box, and other similar facilities b) Dance hall, mahjong parlor, pachinko parlor, and other similar facilities c) Off-track betting ticket sales office of horse race, bicycle race and boat race, and other similar facilities
(4)	Shops operating other service businesses that do not come under the preceding items or (1) to (15) of Appendix 1.

Note: The public facilities listed in Appendix 1 and 2 do not include shops operating store-based adults entertainment special businesses prescribed by paragraph 6, Article 2 of the Act below, or store-based telephonic dating agency business prescribed by paragraph 9 of the same Article.

**Exceptions of Class 2 Facilities: Duty to endeavor (Article 21 of the Ordinance)**

(1)	Facilities used for businesses listed in items 1 to 4, paragraph 1, Article 2 of the Act Regulating Adults Entertainment Business, etc., or prescribed by paragraph 11 of the same Article.
(2)	Restaurants of which total floor areas used for business excluding that of kitchen or equipment are 100 square meters or less.
(3)	Hotels, inns, and other similar facilities of which total floor areas used for business are 700 square meters or less.

**Facilities certified as exempted from application of the regulation (Article 20 of the Ordinance)**

Facilities approved by Governor as falling under any of the following

(1)	Class 2 Facilities which can be used exclusively by specific persons, where there is no possibility of exposure to secondhand smoke for those other than the specific persons
(2)	Shops which operate business to exclusively sell tobacco or smoking tools by having customers smoke in the shops

Tobacco smoke contains many harmful substances, and smoking has adverse health effects. It increases the risk of lung cancer, oral cavity cancer, throat cancer, cardiovascular disease and cerebral stroke.

**Secondhand smoke is dangerous, too!  
It may cause the following symptoms.**

Adults: Lung cancer, cardiovascular disease and nasal sinus cancer  
Children: Decrease of lung functions, otitis media and sudden infant death syndrome  
Pregnant women: Premature delivery and birth of low-weight baby

## Contents of Smoking Control by the Ordinance

### What are the rules?

The Ordinance sets the rules to prevent exposure to secondhand smoke in public facilities which have public space accessible to many or unspecified number of people.

Class 1 Facilities* (No Smoking)	Class 2 Facilities* (No Smoking or Partial Restriction of Smoking)
School, hospital, theater, movie theater, observation gallery, meeting hall, sports facility, public bathhouse, retail shop, financial institution, public transportation, library, social welfare facility, government office/facility, etc.	Restaurant, accommodation, entertainment facility, such as game arcade and karaoke box, shops operating other service businesses (laundry, real-estate agent, barber shop, beauty salon, travel agency, law firm, etc.)

- ◆ Outdoors, residences and offices, of which access is limited to specific persons, are excluded from the regulation of the Ordinance.
- ◆ Facilities are required to display signs, such as "No Smoking" or "Partial Restriction of Smoking", at the entrances.
- ◆ All the facility users are prohibited to smoke in the non-smoking areas.
- ◆ Minors under 20 years old are prohibited to enter the smoking sections/areas.
- ◆ Smoking sections can be set up in any facilities.
- ◆ Facilities covered by the Act Regulating Adults Entertainment Business, etc., such as mahjong and pachinko parlors, and small-scale restaurants and hotels have duty to endeavor to take the prescribed measures. (Exceptions of Class 2 Facilities\*)

\* The types of facilities are detailed on the last page.

### To Prefectural Citizens

#### We request your cooperation for measures to prevent exposure to secondhand smoke!

The Ordinance prescribes the duties of the prefectural citizens to develop understanding of harmful effects of secondhand smoke on health, not to let others be exposed to secondhand smoke, and to endeavor to cooperate in the preventive measures against secondhand smoke. (Article 3)

#### Do not smoke in the non-smoking areas!

Smoking is prohibited in the non-smoking areas. (Article 8)

### To Guardians

#### Please protect minors from exposure to secondhand smoke!

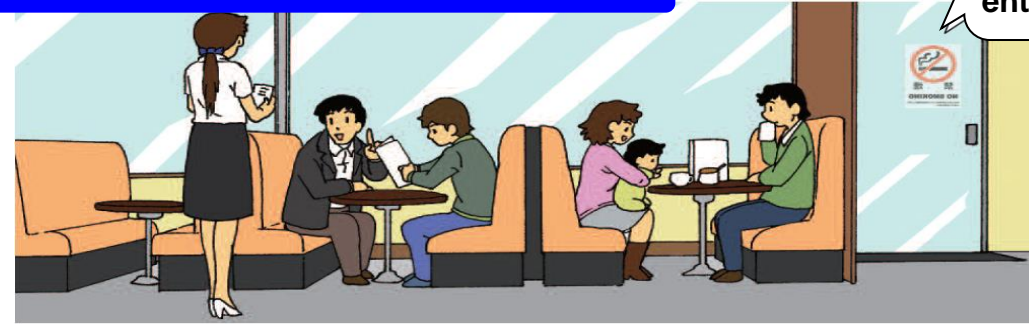
The Ordinance prescribes the duties of guardians to endeavor to prevent harmful effects of secondhand smoke on minors' health. (Article 4)

#### Do not make minors enter the smoking areas/sections!

The Ordinance prescribes that guardians shall not let the minors under their care and supervision enter the smoking areas/sections. (Paragraph 2 of Article 13)

### In case of a restaurant where smoking is prohibited



"No Smoking" sign must be displayed at the facility entrance!



### In case of a restaurant where smoking is partially restricted



Smoke must be emitted outside!

"Smoking Area" sign must be displayed at the entrance! Minors shall not enter the smoking area.

Smoking is prohibited in the hallway as it is a commonly used area.

"Partial Restriction of Smoking" sign must be displayed at the facility entrance!



## No Smoke for Non-smokers

This Ordinance sets new rules to control smoking in the public space to prevent harmful health effects caused by secondhand smoke.

### The Ordinance applies to "heat-not-burn tobacco", too

Please follow the rules when you smoke a heat-not-burn tobacco. Smoking of heat-not-burn tobacco is also prohibited in non-smoking areas.

\*Heat-not-burn tobacco is categorized as Manufactured Tobacco based on the Tobacco Business Law. A special device is used to heat tobacco leaves for smoking them.

### To Facility Managers

#### Please be sure to observe the following!

- Measures must be taken to prohibit smoking in the Class 1 Facilities, and to prohibit or partially restrict smoking in the Class 2 Facilities (Article 9)**  
Facility managers must take appropriate measures to control smoking according to the class of the facility.  
If the facility manager of the Class 2 Facility selects to partially restrict smoking, he must make effort to designate about half or over half of the total area of the facility's public space as the non-smoking area.
- Prevent leakage of smoke (Article 11)**  
To prevent leakage of smoke from the smoking areas/sections into the non-smoking areas, take the necessary measures prescribed by the Ordinance.  
\* Details of the measures are on the website.
- Do not place tools/equipments for smoking in the non-smoking areas (Article 12)**  
Do not place tools and equipments for smoking, such as a smoking stand and an ashtray, in the non-smoking areas.
- Do not let minors enter the smoking areas/sections (Article 13)**  
Do not let minors (excluding employees, etc.) enter the smoking areas/sections.
- Give a caution to violators of the no-smoking rule. (Article 14)**  
Caution smokers in the non-smoking area to stop smoking or leave the area.
- Display signs of "No Smoking", "Partial Restriction of Smoking", etc. (Article 15)**  
Display signs of "No Smoking" or "Partial Restriction of Smoking" prescribed by the Ordinance at the facility entrance. Signs must be also displayed at the entrance of the smoking areas/sections.
