In this moment a mushroom-shaped cloud arose, and then it spread like an umbrella. It finally became a huge umbrella, like a demon that bares his fangs and attacks us.

Two hundred thousand lives were lost in the cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki. 65% of them were children, women and elderly persons.

Among them, 40% are still missing.

In the course of some thousand years of human history, has such a heavy and horrible incident ever happened before?

This collection of testimonies and pictures was made by those who experienced the tragedies of Hiroshima and Nagasaki and who are currently living in Kanagawa Prefecture. Towards the 21st century these Hibakushas (sufferers of the A-bombings) left behind pictures and texts as testimonies of the truth.
