If a child rides a bicycle, parent will be required to obtain the insurance.

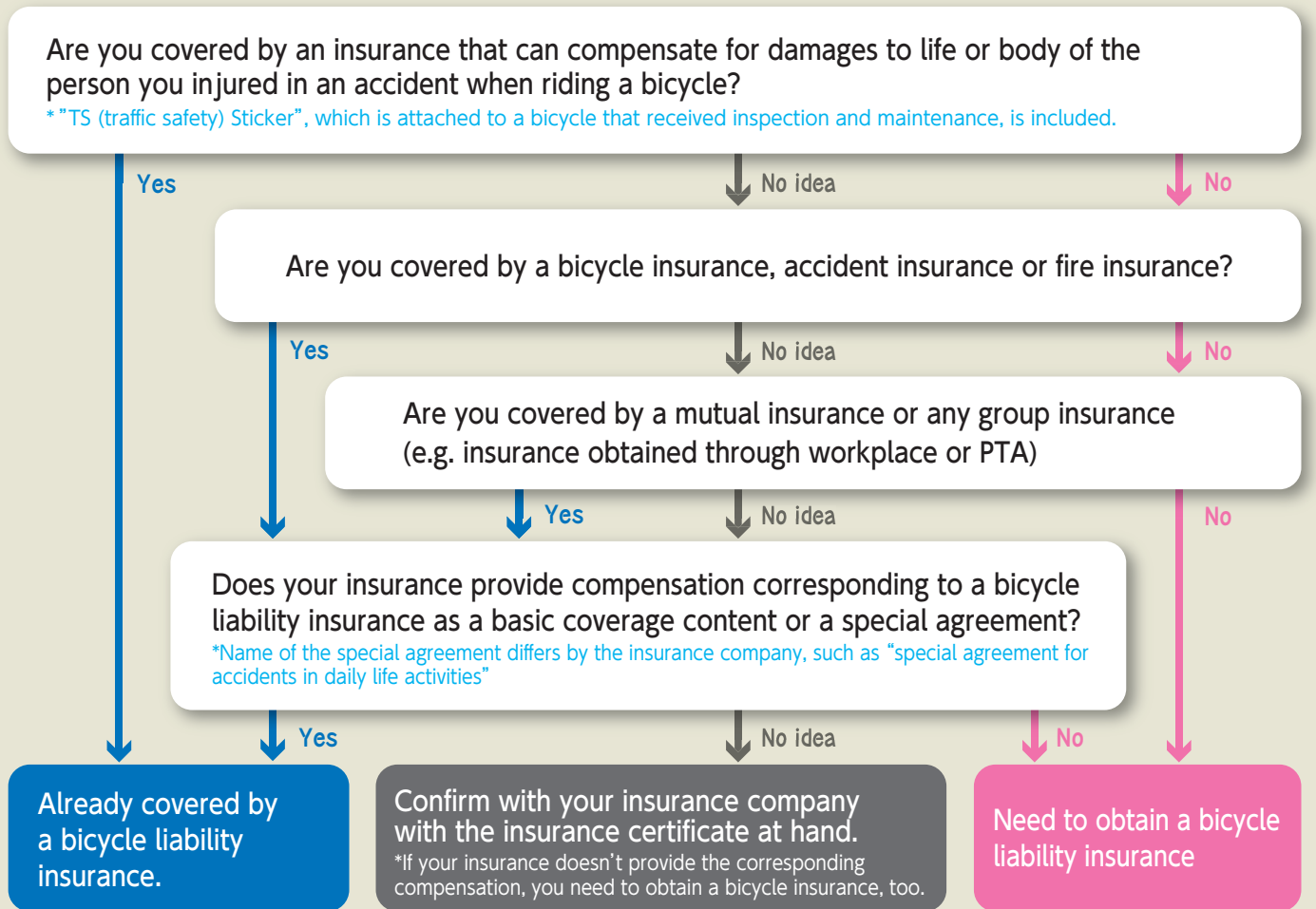


Example of high compensation for a bicycle accident About ¥95 million (At Kobe District Court, July 2013)

In order to promote safe and appropriate use of bicycle, promptly give relief assistance to accident victims and mitigate economic burden of perpetrators, Kanagawa Prefectural Government enforced "Ordinance on Promotion of Safe and Appropriate Use of Bicycle" in April 2019.
