Explanation of Tourist Attraction

Yumemiichi not only provides fresh and safe produce grown in Atsugi City and Kiyokawa Village but also conveys the importance of food, agriculture and local food consumption to the customers. Their original gelato, "Yumemi-chan Ice", which lets you enjoy the rich seasonal tastes of local produce has been granted the "Kanagawa Nadeshiko Brand" designation. Other popular items include produce with the "Kanagawa Brand" designation and original products (steamed soy beans, udon noodles made from locally grown flour, Nurekari-sen rice crackers and Yumemi-chan dressing). In addition to a wide range of events held at the market including agricultural workshops, face-to-face sales by the producers, various fairs, fresh fish sales by the Fisheries Cooperatives and salt-grilling of ayu or sweetfish, programs such as cooking classes are also held in the Training and Communication Room.

Access

Car: [From Atsugi I.C. on the Tomei Expressway] Drive on National Route 129 toward Central Atsugi. Turn left at the Bunka Kaikan-mae intersection and head straight. Drive straight past the Onna-nakamachi intersection. Turn left at the Tokyonogyo-daigaku (Tokyo University of Agriculture) Entrance intersection and drive 100m. The market is to the left of the Shohoku-tankidaigaku (Shohoku College) Entrance intersection.
Train: Get off at Hon-Atsugi Station on Odakyu Line and take a bus bound for Mori no Sato (Atsu-44 Route via Akabane and Mt. Takamatsu) at the Atsugi Bus Center, or from the south exit of Hon-Atsugi Station take a bus bound for Tokyo University of Agriculture (Atsu-109 Route). Get off at the Akabane Chuo bus stop and walk for 1 minute.



Nanasawa Onsen Fukumotokan (day-trip bathing)



The room where the representative author of proletarian literature in Japan, Takiji Kobayashi, secretly stayed is still preserved to this day together with the small bowls, charcoal heater, cupboard, outerwear and so on used by him. The hot spring is strongly alkaline with a pH over 10.0 and is characterized by its smooth and silky texture.
