# Izumibashi Shuzo (Izumibashi Sake Brewery)



### Explanation of Tourist Attraction

With the belief that making sake starts from growing rice, Izumibashi Shuzo integrally produces sake, from the cultivation and refining of rice for sake to brewing of sake in Ebina City and its surrounding areas as a rare Japanese sake brewery which cultivates rice. The company's motto in making sake is to carefully brew the trustworthy and reliable rice grown in plenty of sunlight and earth. They aspire to provide their original Izumibashi sake that can allow people to have an enjoyable time chatting with their friends while being comfortably drunk. They are also making efforts to reduce the use of agricultural chemicals and adopt organic agriculture. The Izumibashi Shuzo adapts a red dragonfly as the symbol of the company, to sustain the local land with many dragonflies flying in the autumn sky and deliver the safe and secure sake to customers.
