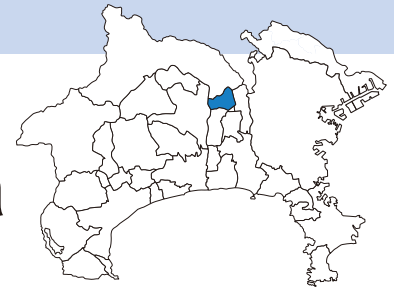

**Sunflower Field in Zama**



Explanation of  
Tourist Attraction

This sunflower field is the largest in the area, with 550,000 sunflowers that bloom all at once. Sunflower festivals are held at Kurihara and Zama venues from the end of July to mid August. During the events, there are sunflower cutting, selling of agricultural products, a pony ride experience, Ayu picking, and a sunflower photo contest. From the observation platform, a breathtaking yellow panoramic view spreading throughout the field touches everyone's heart. Sunflower Field is open at all times and is now popular among youth as the best spot for instagram photos.

Public transportation/ Kurihara Venue: From Soubudai-mae Station (Odakyu Line), take the bus bound for Minamirinkan Station, get off at Zama Sogo Kouko-mae, walk 1 min.  
Zama venue: From Zama Station (Odakyu Line), take the bus bound for Zama Yotsuya, get off at Jinja-mae, walk 10 mins.  
During the festival, temporary shuttle bus is operated from Soubudai-mae Station (Odakyu Line)  
Car / Kurihara Venue: 8 km from Keno Atsugi Interchange via Keno Expressway.  
Zama Venue: 5km from Keno Atsugi Interchange via Keno Expressway
