Tourist Attraction

Kana Garden is a place where you can learn about and have fun at a garden and farm at the same time. The Garden features some of the most prominent rose varieties in the Kanto region. A Rose Festival is held in Spring and Autumn. Vegetable Harvesting Workshops are also held on weekends and during the Summer vacation. The approximately 9.2 hectare garden, with its light and free atmosphere, is divided into 3 zones: the Flower Zone, featuring many seasonal flowers such as flowering peach trees, cherry blossoms, roses, and clematis; the Agri-Zone, where you can try planting rice or harvesting vegetables; and the Megumi no Kenkyu-to Zone, with its exhibition rooms, kitchens, and library. Enjoy the flowers and nature of the four seasons. *No English language support is currently available.

Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Shonan-Daira



Shonan-Daira is popular with couples as the best-known night view in Kanagawa Prefecture. Shonan-Daira overlooks Enoshima and Mt. Fuji, and the views are even more spectacular around sunset.

Izumo Oyashiro Shrine Sagami Branch



Many seasonal events are held here, including the New Year Fukumukae ("Fortune-Bringing") Festival, the Plum Festival in Spring, the Chinese Lantern Plant Market and the Morning Glory Market in Summer. There is a fresh water spring, known as Sennen no Mori no Mizu ("Waters of the 1,000-year forest"), on the shrine grounds. In Summer, fireflies come to the area and create a fantastic sight.
