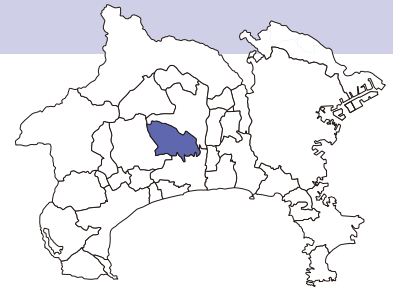

The highest point you can travel by bus in Tanzawa

Yabitsu Pass and Canola Flower Garden



Explanation of Tourist Attraction

Yabitsu Pass is located in the middle of Route No. 70 connecting to Route 246 and Miyagase Lake in Tanzawa mountains that are 761m above sea level. It is the highest point that can be reached by the local bus and one of the popular hiking/climbing spots known for its ease to reach the summit in just one hour. Moreover, as there are places where you can overlook Hadano, Odawara and as far as Hiratsuka, it is the best spot for powerful night views and popular also among those who enjoy touring and cycling. The wooden observation deck called "Nanohanadai" is located between Hadano and Yabitsu pass and visitors can view Sagami Bay, Enoshima, and Mt. Fuji. It is a popular spot in Hadano City where many people visit day and night.

<Yabitsu Pass> Bus: From Hadano Station (Odakyu Line), take the bus 【秦 21】 bound for Yabitsu Toge (Pass) for 45 mins., and get off at Yabitsu Pass.
Car: Approx. 40 minutes from Hadano Nakai Interchange (Tomei Expressway)
Walk: Approx. 1 hour to Oyama

<Canola Flower Garden> Bus: Take the same bus (mentioned above) and get off at Nanohanadai.
Car: Approx. 30 mins. from Hadano Nakai Interchange (Tomei Expressway)
*There are few buses available for this route. Please be sure to check the departure times.

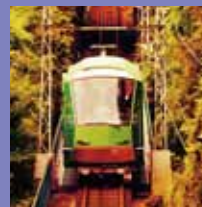
Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Oyama-Afuri Shrine



An old shrine that is said to have been built over two thousand years ago. Starting with the rain ritual, it was known for its sacred spirit that many warlords admired and soon Oyama-moude, which is to visit the mountaintop for its sacred rituals, became popular among climbers. Oyama-moude was designated as part of Japanese heritage last year. A view from the Afuri Shrine is introduced with two Michelin stars.

Oyama-Cable



The Oyama cable car travels on a steep slope of 0.8 km and can run the height distance of 278 m quickly in about 6 minutes, offering a superb view at its highest peak of 700 m. Visitors can see Enoshima and the natural four seasons of Oyama through the windows.
