Hakone Sekisho Tabimonogatari Kan (Japanese Cultural Experience)



Explanation of Tourist Attraction

We used to provide a simple costume rental service so that overseas visitors to Hakone could enjoy dressing up like ninjas and Edo-period magistrates, and we opened a facility in July 2017 in which visitors can experience Japanese culture through the history and natural environment of Hakone. The kimono-dressing experience enables visitors to choose the colors and patterns they prefer from around forty different kimonos and then take a stroll around Hakone Sekisho, Hakone Shrine and other famous and sites and ruins located near Lake Ashinoko. The matcha experience enables visitors to taste matcha green tea that they have brewed themselves, together with Japanese sweets.
