Manyo Park
("Doppo no Yu" footbath)Explanation of
Tourist Attraction

Many old plants featured in ancient Japanese texts are grown in Manyo Park, located in the center of a hot spring town. The park features the Manyo-tei that was built to resemble an ancient building, a monument engraved with the only poem about hot springs in the ancient Manyo poems, and a monument to Doppo Kunikida. Energy from the sun can be felt in the park from an image of the Japanese archipelago, created by applying geography and Chinese geomancy. Doppo no Yu is a footbath that uses the water from the hot springs. This footbath facility has nine springs, and the bottom of the bathtub is textured to stimulate pressure points on your feet, so you can experience a massage with different effects. Footbath rates : Adults (More than 15 years of age) ¥300 / Elementary and Junior high school students ¥200
