Explanation of
Tourist Attraction

Ashigarigo Setoyashiki is the house of the Seto family which served as Nanushi (village headman) of this area for a long time. There are a traditional thatch-roofed main house, storehouse, mill, etc. on premises of approx. 6,000 square meters, and various traditional annual events, such as the Doll Festival, the Boys' Festival and Tanabata, or the Star Festival, are recreated. It is an important historical cultural asset which has been showing the rural lifestyle of the Edo period along with the beautiful landscape of pure water and waterway, farmland and homestead woodland in the Ashigara Plain. It was first to be designated as an important cultural property by Kaisei Town.




Nearby Sightseeing Spot

Ajisai (hydrangea) Festival



There are 5,000 hydrangeas among the vast paddy fields which total about 3.6 times the size of Tokyo Dome. You can leisurely stroll around, feeling like a snail, while enjoying the view of the green paddy fields with freshly planted rice and rainbow-colored hydrangeas in bloom.

Kaisei Kori Kori Don (a rice bowl dish)



Kori Kori Don is a rice bowl dish comprised of the plate and flank of Ashigara cows and locally-produced rice and vegetables. Each restaurant has its own Kori Kori Don with different seasonings and ingredients. The dish has become popular as a local specialty that can be enjoyed at restaurants in the town.
