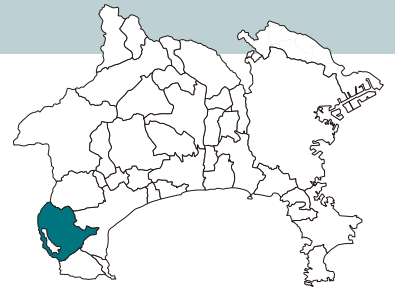

Hakone Shrine



In the past, Hakone Shrine was once a place of worship for the Kanto's region local deity, Hakone Daigongen. 2,400 years ago, during the reign of Emperor Koshu, the 5th emperor of Japan, Shosen-shonin began to worship Mount Hakone's Mount Komagatake (the original location of this shrine) as a holy place, and since then, it has been a great sacred mountain in the Kanto region.
