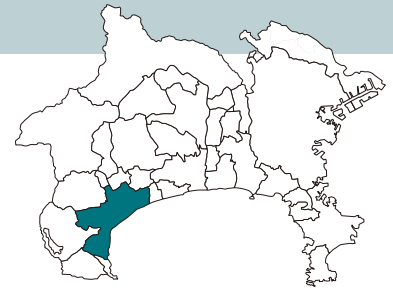

At the Kamaboko Museum, in addition to the popular activity of hand-making kamaboko and chikuwa, there are new programs and hands-on exhibits. At "Agekama Hand-making Workshop"(Time:30 mins.), you can make your own deep-fried kamaboko and eat it, too. At "Suzunari Ichiba", there are one hundred famous items and souvenirs from Odawara and Hakone, including our famous Kamaboko. Restaurants and cafes are also available.

Kanagawa Prefectural Museum of Natural History



This museum shows the history and diversity of life on this planet in easy to understand ways, following the passage of time over the 4.6 billion years of this planet of life, Earth. The Exhibition presents over 10,000 pieces of real specimens, ranging from skeletons of gargantuan dinosaurs or meteors to tiny insects.

Choukouzan Shotai-ji Temple



This famous weeping cherry tree is 340 years old and is designated as a natural monument of Odawara City. This tree was planted by the second daimyo of Odawara, Masanori Inaba, with his wish to "remember the spring by".
