After dressing up, please take a commemorative photo in front of Odawara Castle where the "Great Renovation of Heisei" was completed in 2016.

Nearby Sightseeing Spot

**Hotoku Ninomiya Shrine**



A shrine located in the immediate vicinity of Odawara Castle. It deifies Ninomiya Sontoku who saved a lot of rural areas and clans from poverty in the late Edo period and pursued people's happiness with his own ideals and practicalism. Festivals are held in April and September.

**Uiro**



The Uiro store in Odawara is the oldest long-established store in Kanagawa Prefecture. Members of the Uiro clan have run the business for over six centuries. Uiro confectionery features elasticity and simple yet subtle sweetness. First created 600 years ago for foreign delegations, uiro is made by steaming rice flour.
