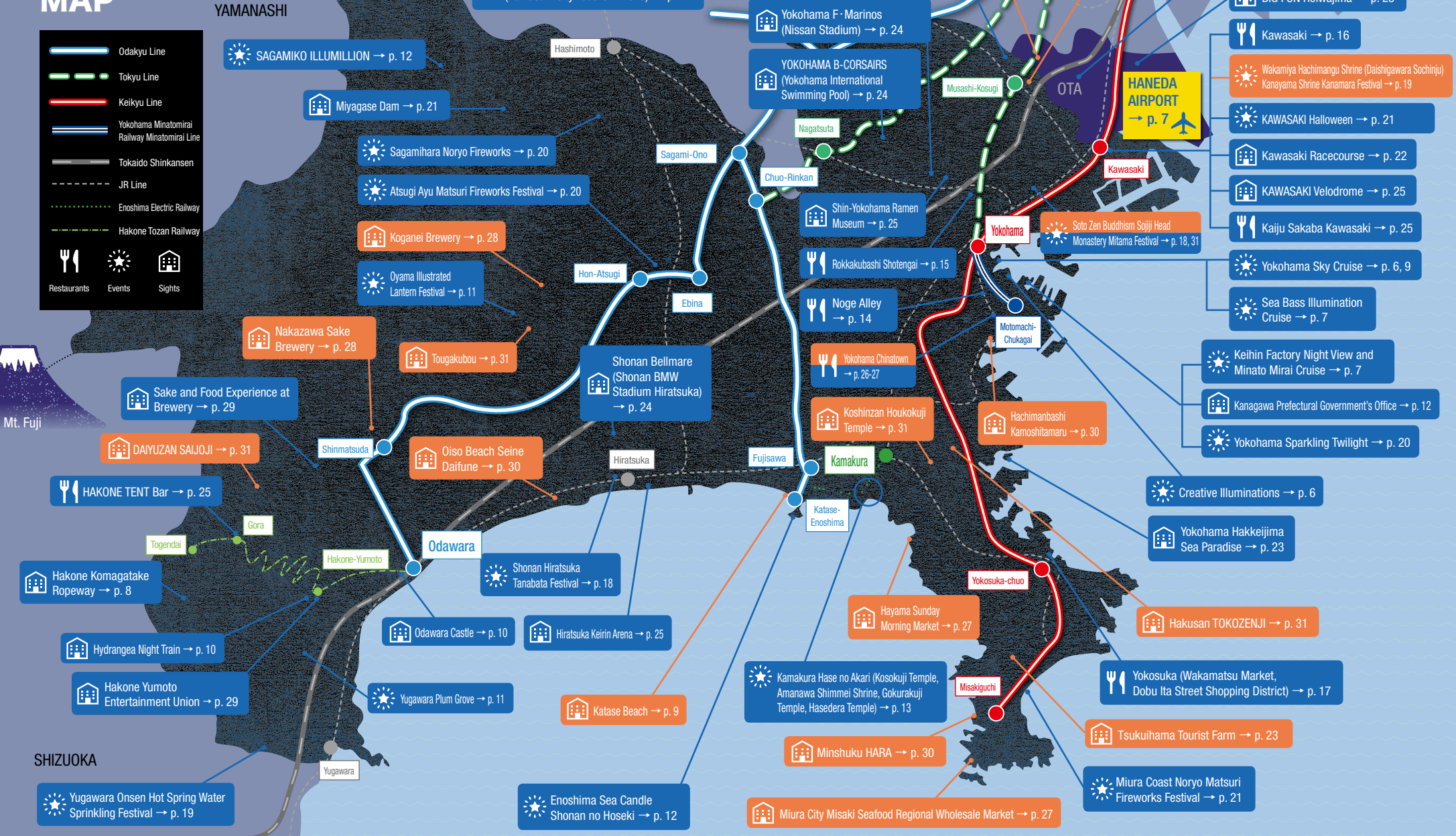

When night falls at Odawara Castle's Honmaru square, they hold the "Odawara Castle Cherry Blossom Light-up: Night Cherry Blossoms Dyed in Light" event, creating an even more magical atmosphere. 📍 6-1 Jonai, Odawara City 🕒 Late Mar.-Early Apr. every year 🚶 Approx. 10 min. walk from Odawara Sta. Collaborative projection mapping events are also sometimes held. However, as these are held irregularly, seeing one is a pretty special experience!

Natural Beauty of the Seasons Woven with Light and the Night Sky

Spring, summer, fall, and winter. The appearance of the town changes with each of Japan's four seasons, like when the cherry blossoms bloom in spring, or when the mountains are covered in the vivid red foliage of fall. Gaze at World Heritage Mt. Fuji The Symbol of Japan

At 3,776 meters, Mt. Fuji is Japan's highest peak. In recent years, climbing it has been gaining popularity even among international tourists.

Of course we recommend climbing it, but first you should see how beautiful it is.

Here we highlight Kanagawa Prefecture's special spots that you can see Mt. Fuji from!

Enjoy a great 360-degree panorama from the observation platform at the summit of Hakone's Mt. Komagatake

Katase Beach

Spots where Mt. Fuji is visible across the sea are rare even in Japan. Viewpoints we recommend include Enoshima as well as points between Katase-Enoshima Station and Enoshima, like Enoshima Bentenbashi Bridge, Nishihama Beach, and Kugenuma Beach. 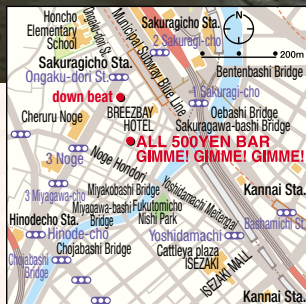

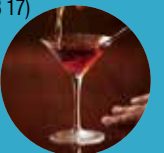
