Please share the challenges of working at a Japanese company

In internal meetings, because I am talking with people I meet and work with on a daily basis, I can communicate naturally without feeling nervous or anxious. However, when participating in meetings with people outside the company, since they are clients, I need to be fully prepared for all aspects of business hospitality. I also have to practice proper business manners and use honorific language appropriately. At the beginning, I was not able to respond smoothly. However, by repeating the process many times—learning while working—I gradually became accustomed to it and was able to improve my skills.

How do you spend your time after work?

Currently, I spend about one hour each day studying for the certification I am aiming to obtain. As an IT engineer, there are many fundamental certifications available in the information technology field, and I have gradually realized that this knowledge is essential for expanding the range of projects I can handle. Therefore, I make an effort to study a little every day in order to earn additional certifications. I believe it is important to use my personal time effectively and devote part of it to learning for my own future.
