When you are in trouble... (how to make emergency calls)

【指差して伝える緊急事態】

< You can make yourself understood by simply pointing out the following sentences to a Japanese if you wish to make an emergency call >

【救急】救急車の呼び出し(消防署)

Ambulance Call : **119** (Fire Station)

- ・(病気で)具合が悪いので、救急車を呼んでください。
< I'm ill. Please call an ambulance. >
- ・けがをしたので、救急車を呼んでください。
< I'm injured. Please call an ambulance. >

【警察】窃盗/犯罪/交通事故(警察)

Theft/Crime/Traffic Accident, Call : **110** (Police)

- ・(盗難にあったので)、警察を呼んでください。
< (I've been robbed) Please call the police. >
- ・(交通事故にあったので)、警察を呼んでください。
< (I have been in a traffic accident) Please call the police. >

※日本人の方へ → 外国人観光客の代わりに電話してあげてください。

【文章を指差して、日本人に尋ねる】

< Ask your question by pointing out the sentences in Japanese >

- 今いる場所はどこですか? < Where are we now? >
(After showing this sentence to a Japanese, ask the person to read the map.)
- ここへ行きたいのですが、道は正しいですか?
< I want to go to this place. Is this the right road? >
(After showing this sentence to a Japanese, ask the person to read the map.)
- この電車で、〇〇に行けますか? < Can we go to 〇〇 on this train? >
