

Class 1 Facilities: No smoking (Appendix 1 of the Ordinance)

(1)	Kindergarten, elementary school, junior-high school, senior-high school, university, and other similar facilities
(2)	a) Hospital, clinic b) Pharmacy c) Parlors of Japanese traditional massage, massage, finger pressure; acupuncture; moxocautery; and judo-orthopaedics therapy
(3)	Theater, movie theater
(4)	Observation gallery
(5)	a) Meeting hall b) Crematorium c) Shrine, temple, church, and other similar facilities
(6)	Exhibition hall
(7)	Gymnasium, swimming pool, bowling alley, and other sports facilities
(8)	Public bathhouse
(9)	Department store, supermarket, and other retail shops
(10)	Bank and other financial institutions
(11)	Postal, telecommunication, waterworks, electric power or gas service business office
(12)	(a) Public transportation facilities used by passengers, such as railway station (b) Train, car and other vehicles or ship which are used for transportation of passengers (of which routes start or finish at a point within the prefecture)
(13)	Library, museum, art gallery, and other similar facilities
(14)	Zoo, botanical garden, amusement park, and other similar facilities
(15)	Nursing home for the elderly, children's day-care center, children's welfare facility, welfare facility for persons with disabilities, and other similar facilities
(16)	Government office/facility
(17)	Building or structure where public facilities listed in the above or Appendix 2 are located (public areas only; for example, entrance, hallway, stairs, elevator, restroom, etc.)

Class 2 Facilities: No smoking or partial restriction of smoking (Appendix 2 of the Ordinance)

(1)	a) Restaurant b) Cabaret, café, nightclub, and other similar facilities
(2)	Hotel, inn, and other similar facilities
(3)	a) Amusement arcade, karaoke club, and other similar facilities b) Dance hall, mah-jong parlor, pachinko parlor, and other similar facilities c) Offtrack betting booth for horse races, and other similar facilities
(4)	Shops operating other service businesses that do not come under the previous items or (1) to (15) of Appendix 1.

Note: The public facilities listed in Appendix 1 and 2 do not include shops operating "store-type adults entertainment special businesses, etc."

Exceptions of Class 2 Facilities: Duty to endeavor for taking the prescribed measures (Article 21 of the Ordinance)

(1)	Facilities such as pachinko parlors and mah-jong parlors, which are subject to the Act Regulating Adults Entertainment Business, etc.
(2)	Small-scale restaurants of which total floor areas excluding kitchens are 100 square meters or less.
(3)	Accommodation facilities of which total floor areas are 700 square meters or less.

Public Facilities Certified by the Governor: Exclusion from the control (Article 20 of the Ordinance)
Facilities certified by the Governor as those listed below

(1)	Facilities among the Class 2 Facilities which are used exclusively by the specific persons, and where there is no possibility of causing secondhand smoke exposure to those other than the specific persons
(2)	Shops which operate the business to exclusively sell tobacco or pipe by having customers smoke in their premises

Tobacco smoke contains many harmful substances, and smoking has adverse health effects of increasing the risk of lung cancer, oral cavity cancer, throat cancer, cardiovascular disease and cerebral stroke.

Secondhand Smoke is Dangerous, too! It may cause the following symptoms.

- Adults: Lung cancer, cardiovascular disease and nasal sinus cancer
- Children: Decrease of lung functions, otitis media and sudden infant death syndrome
- Pregnant women: Premature delivery and birth of low-weight baby

Contents of Smoking Control by the Ordinance

What are the rules?

The Ordinance sets the rules to prevent exposure to secondhand smoke in public facilities which have public space accessible to unspecified people or multitude of people.

Class 1 Facilities* (No Smoking)	Class 2 Facilities* (No Smoking or Partial Restriction of Smoking)
School, hospital, theater, movie theater, observation gallery, meeting hall, library, sports facility, public bathhouse,	Restaurant, hotel, entertainment facility such as amusement arcade and karaoke club, shops operating other service
retail shop, financial institution, public transportation, social welfare facility, government office/facility, etc.	businesses(laundry, real-estate agent, barber, hair dresser, travel agency, law firm, etc.)

The outdoors, dwelling houses and offices, of which access is limited to the specific persons, are excluded from the regulation of the Ordinance.

The facilities are required to display signs, such as “ No Smoking ” and “ Partial Restriction of Smoking ”, at the entrances.

All the facility users are subject to the ban on smoking in the non-smoking areas. Minors under 20 years old are prohibited to enter the smoking sections or smoking areas.

Smoking sections can be set up in all the facilities.

The Ordinance does not regulate the facilities which are covered by the Act Regulating Adults Entertainment Business, etc., such as mah-jong and pachinko parlors, and small-scale restaurants and hotels. However, these facilities have duty to endeavor to take the prescribed measures.

To the Prefectural Citizens

Please cooperate with us in the implementation of measures to prevent exposure to secondhand smoke!

The Ordinance prescribes the duties to be performed by the prefectural citizens; namely, to develop understanding of harmful effects of secondhand smoke on health, to avoid exposing others to secondhand smoke, and to endeavor to cooperate in the preventive measures against secondhand smoke. (Article 3)

Do not smoke in the non-smoking areas!

Smoking is prohibited in the non-smoking areas. (Article 8)

To Guardians

Please protect minors under 20 years old from their exposure to secondhand smoke!

The Ordinance prescribes the duties to be performed by guardians to endeavor to prevent harmful effects of secondhand smoke on minors' health. (Article 4)

Do not make minors enter the smoking areas and smoking sections!

The Ordinance prescribes that guardians shall not make the minors in their care and custody enter the smoking areas and smoking sections. (Paragraph 2 of Article 13)

In case of a restaurant where smoking is prohibited



“ No Smoking ” sign must be displayed at the facility entrance!



In case of a restaurant where smoking is partially restricted

Smoking is prohibited in the hallway as it is a commonly used area.

“ Partial Restriction of Smoking ” sign must be displayed at the facility entrance!

To Facility Managers

Please be sure to observe the following!

- Measures must be taken to prohibit smoking in the Class 1 Facilities, and to prohibit or partially restrict smoking in the Class 2 Facilities. (Article 9)**
Facility managers must take the appropriate measures to control smoking according to the class of the facility.
If the facility manager of the Class 2 Facility select to partially restrict smoking, he must make effort to designate about half or over half of the total area of the facility's public space as the non-smoking area.
- Prevent leakage of smoke. (Article 11)**
To prevent leakage of smoke from the smoking areas/sections into the non-smoking areas, take the necessary measures prescribed by the Ordinance.

- Do not place tools and equipment for smoking in the non-smoking areas. (Article 12)**
Do not place tools and equipment for smoking, such as a smoking stand and an ashtray, in the non-smoking areas.
- Do not make minors enter the smoking areas/sections. (Article 13)**
Do not make minors (excluding employees, etc.) enter the smoking areas/sections.
- Give a caution to violators of the no-smoking rule. (Article 14)**
Caution smokers in the non-smoking areas to stop smoking or leave the non-smoking areas.
- Display signs of “ No Smoking ”, “ Partial Restriction of Smoking ”, etc. (Article 15)**
Display signs of “ No Smoking ” or “ Partial Restriction of Smoking ” prescribed by the Ordinance at the facility entrance. Signs must be also displayed at the entrance of the smoking areas/sections.

No smoke for non-smokers
This Ordinance sets new rules to control smoking in the public space to prevent harmful health effects caused by secondhand smoke.

Penalties are imposed.

As penalties, a fine of ¥20,000 or less is imposed on persons who have smoked in the non-smoking areas, and ¥50,000 or less on facility managers who have not fulfilled their duties prescribed by the Ordinance. (Article 23)
