MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY, MEDICAL CORPORATION TOKUSHUKAI, JAPAN AIRPORT TERMINAL CO., LTD. AND THE KANAGAWA PREFECTURAL GOVERNMENT FOR GLOBAL CONTRIBUTION TO MEDICINE AND HEALTHCARE

The Ohio State University (hereinafter "OSU"), Medical Corporation Tokushukai (hereinafter "Tokushukai"), Japan Airport Terminal Co., Ltd. (hereinafter "JATCO"), and the Kanagawa Prefectural Government (hereinafter "KPG"), (OSU, Tokushukai, JATCO and KPG are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually a "Party"), through Japan-U.S. cooperation, shall make every effort to find a way to go forward by effectively utilizing each Party's human and financial resources in order to contribute globally in the fields of medicine and healthcare, in the Indo-Pacific and other regions, including the dissemination of the advanced medical technology and the concept of ME-BYO, and the development of international medical human resources.

In order to implement this MOU, the Parties shall consider establishing the OSU-Tokushukai Joint Clinic in Tokyo-Haneda: the International ME-BYO Center of Excellence (tentative name, hereinafter the "Center") in the passenger terminal of Tokyo International Airport (Haneda). In addition, the Parties shall consider having functions within Shonan Kamakura General Hospital that will contribute to the development of medical care in Japan and the United States.

Based on this common understanding, the Parties shall aim to build a new model that will contribute to Universal Health Coverage (UHC) through cooperative actions and initiatives.

オハイオ州立大学、医療法人徳洲会、日本空港ビルデング株式会社 及び神奈川県との医療・ヘルスケアの国際貢献に関する覚書

- オハイオ州立大学(OSU)、医療法人徳洲会、日本空港ビルデング株式会社及び神奈川県の四者は、日米連携の下で、最新の医療技術の発信や未病コンセプトの普及、国際医療人材の育成など、医療・ヘルスケア分野でのインド・太平洋を中心とした地域における国際貢献に資するため、相互に有する人的及び財政的資源を有効活用し、協調して鋭意取り組むこととする。
- この内容を具体化するため、四者は OSU-Tokushukai Joint Clinic in Tokyo-Haneda ~International ME-BYO Center of Excellence~(国際未病・医療センター(仮称))を東京国際(羽田)空港旅客ターミナルビル内に開設するとともに、湘南鎌倉総合病院内において、日米医療の発展に貢献するための機能を検討する。
- こうした共通認識のもと、四者は互いに協調し、主導力を発揮することにより、 ユニバーサル・ヘルス・カバレッジ(UHC)にも貢献する新たなモデルケースの構 築を目指す。
