

What are developmental disabilities?

“Developmental disabilities” are broadly defined as disorders of brain function, such as autism, Asperger’s syndrome, other pervasive developmental disorders, learning disorders and attention deficit hyperactivity disorders, and other similar disorders, the symptoms of which usually appear at a young age, as specified by Cabinet Order.

(Article 2 of the Act on Support for Persons with Development Disabilities)

What is Support Center for Persons with Developmental Disabilities?

Kanagawa Prefecture Support Center for Persons with Developmental Disabilities is a facility to provide comprehensive support for people with developmental disabilities, their families and relevant organizations in Kanagawa, excluding the cities of Yokohama, Kawasaki and Sagami-hara).
