If you are diagnosed with COVID-19 at a medical institution

The information on this flyer is for people **who don't meet** any of the conditions below

1. Person 65 years of age or older
2. Person whose hospitalization is judged as necessary by a doctor
3. Person who has a risk of developing serious symptoms, and needs administration of medicine for COVID-19 or oxygen due to the infection
4. Pregnant person

You will receive no contact from the public health center.

Please register with the positive patients' registration desk. After registration, K.P.G. will send you information on recuperation by SMS. You can do health check or seek advice on visiting a doctor, etc. on LINE.

**Be sure to prepare documents* to show that you are
COVID-19-positive**

*Documents to show that you tested positive, such as the result of PCR test, prescription of medication for COVID-19, documents on medical treatment details, medical treatment cost invoice and receipt (with information on corona treatment), etc.



Q1. If I register with the positive patients' registration desk, what can I do?

1. You can do health check on LINE for your self-care
2. You can use the recuperation facility
(There are certain requirements, such as having a difficulty in home quarantine as living with the elderly who has a high risk of developing severe symptoms.)
3. You can use the food delivery service (limited to people in need)
4. You can use K.P.G. Corona Emergency Call 119 (for consultation when your health deteriorates, etc.)

After registration, you will be given **positive patient's number** and information on recuperation will be sent to your e-mail address from K.P.G. Please keep it until the end of recuperation.

*Even if you register, the certificate of completion of recuperation will not be issued.



Q2. How long should I recuperate?

If you have symptoms and diagnosed as being infected, your recuperation will end seven days after **the day of onset (the first day you develop symptoms)** and 24 hours following improvement of your symptoms.

If you develop no symptom during recuperation, your recuperation will end **seven days after the day when a sample is collected (when you are tested)**. If you do test by yourself using the antigen test kit on the fifth day and the test result is negative, you can end your recuperation on the sixth day.

Avoid going to work/school and unessential outings during recuperation.

Q3. Can I go out during recuperation?

After 24 hours since your symptoms improve, or if you develop no symptoms, you can go out for a minimum time, for glossary shopping, etc. In this case, be sure to take thorough anti-virus measures, such as wearing a mask.
